



SELLING ALCOHOL AT OMBERSLEY MEMORIAL HALL DECLARATION BY HIRER

As a hirer of Ombersley Memorial Hall I understand that:

1. Ombersley Memorial Hall Committee holds a premises licence in respect of Ombersley Memorial Hall. The premises licence is issued by Wychavon District Council under the Licensing Act 2003 and authorises the premises to be used for various forms of regulated entertainment and the sale by retail of alcohol.
2. I must notify the Ombersley Memorial Hall Committee in advance if alcohol is to be sold from the Hall during the hiring period.
3. Alcohol must not be sold to, or consumed by, any person under the age of 18
4. Those responsible for making sales of alcohol must adopt a "Challenge 25" age verification policy in respect of such sales so that any person who appear to the seller to be under the age of 25 must be asked to provide photographic proof of their age to demonstrate they are 18 years of age or over.
5. Alcohol must not be sold to any person who is drunk.
6. Alcohol must not be sold by any person under the age of 18 unless each such sale of alcohol has been specifically approved by a responsible person who is over the age of 18.
7. Alcohol must only be sold within the hours permitted by the premises licence which are:

10am to 11pm
8. If the above requirements are not complied with, my refundable deposit may be subject to forfeiture.
